As the majority of payments move away from cash to card and tablet/mobile payments,* it is vital that charities capitalise on this change in consumer payment habits. Making donations easier and more convenient allows an increasing number of charities to keep raising valuable donations to good causes.

raffle and auction payments as well as donations, with great success. Over £75,000 was raised through the platform on the night, with 44% of raffle tickets bought with credit cards.

Find a Better Way

Sir Bobby Charlton's Find a Better Way charity is dedicated to the elimination of land mines around the world. At a Gala Dinner, DONATE was used for immediate donations and auction payments, raising 17 times the amount raised at the previous year's event.

Battersea Arts Centre

While firefighters were putting out the blaze at Battersea Arts Centre in March 2015, fundraisers were using media coverage of the fire to raise much-needed emergency funds. Over E80,000 was raised in four days from more than 3,000 public donations.



A traditional emergency fundraising campaign using volunteers with donation buckets might have resulted in E5,000 to E10,000 in donations; at E80,000 in four days, DONATE has moved us to a completely new level.
